Dear Families,

The school spreads the safe messages around this but it is up to families to make sure they drive and park safely.















Umbrellas:

When it rains, umbrellas are a great way to stay dry. However, in our playgrounds, umbrellas can cause some concern and we have had some near misses of injuries. To help avoid this, please think about the following to keep everyone safe:

- Only use umbrellas when in the open, umbrellas are to be put down under our cover walkways
- When using an umbrella look up and put the phone away I have seen adults and children
 walk into other people, almost hit poles because they are not paying attention
- Please have as many people under the one umbrella so we have less umbrellas in our playground
- Teach your child to use an umbrella correctly it should never be waved around and look out for people around you.



We need to be aware and look out for each other when we have so many umbrellas in the playground. Use our covered walkways and then put up your or take down your umbrella in a safe space and way. If we do this, we minimise the risk of any unfortunate accidents.


Specialist News
